

**NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING
PURSUANT TO NEW YORK GENERAL MUNICIPAL LAW §859-a
ON PROPOSED PROJECT AND FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE**

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that a public hearing pursuant to Section 859-a of the New York General Municipal Law will be held by the County of Oswego Industrial Development Agency (the “Agency”) on the 15 day of November, 2019 at 11:00 o’clock a.m., local time, at 2320 Co. Rt. 7, Town of Oswego, New York, in connection with the following matter:

Champlain Valley Specialty of New York Inc., a New York business corporation, on behalf of itself and/or entities formed or to be formed on behalf of the foregoing (the “**Company**”), filed an application with the Agency requesting that the Agency consider undertaking a project (the “**Project**”) consisting of: (A)(i) the acquisition of a leasehold interest (or sub-leasehold interest) in approximately 23.3 acres of improved real property located at 8011 State Route 104 and 8033 State Route 104 in the Town of Oswego, State of New York (Tax ID # 181.00-02-12.01 and 181.00-02-12.02) (“the “**Land**”); (ii) (1) the reconstruction and renovation of the building (the “**Existing Building**”) located at 8033 State Route 104; and (2) the construction of a waste water treatment facility (collectively, the “**Facility**”); and (iii) the acquisition and installation in and around the Facility and/or for use in connection with the Project Facility of various machinery, equipment, furnishings and other items of tangible personal property (collectively the “**Equipment**”) (the Land, the Facility and Equipment are hereinafter collectively referred to as the “**Project Facility**”), such Project Facility to be used as a warehouse, storage, manufacturing and fresh fruit processing facility, including an on-site private wastewater treatment facility; (B) the granting of certain financial assistance in the form of exemptions from real property taxes, mortgage recording tax (except as limited by Section 874 of the Act) and State and local sales and use tax (collectively, the “**Financial Assistance**”); and (C) the lease (or sub-lease) of the Project Facility by the Agency pursuant to a lease agreement; the acquisition by the Agency of an interest in the Equipment pursuant to a bill of sale from the Company; and the sublease of the Project Facility back to the Company pursuant to a sublease agreement.

The Company will be the initial owner of the Project Facility.

The Agency has not made a decision with respect to the undertaking of the Project or the granting of the Financial Assistance.

The Agency will at the above-stated time and place hear all persons with views in favor of or opposed to the Project and/or the Financial Assistance. A copy of the Company’s application including a cost/benefit analysis is available at the office of the Agency for review by interested persons.
